Subject: United Waste Information

Good Afternoon PrairieStar Residents,

We have recently received some questions and feedback regarding our new trash and recycling provider United Waste Systems—please find below answers to these questions, and well as other useful information:

- United Waste Systems has a special contract with the District, and therefore the services they provide to PrairieStar are different from those they provide to any other area of Berthoud.
 - When calling United Waste, <u>be sure to mentioned that you are a PrairieStar</u>
 <u>resident</u>—this way they will respond to your questions and requests appropriately.
 - If no one answers when you call, **be sure to leave a voicemail with your name**, address, and also that you are a PrairieStar resident.
 - You can also email them at <u>unitedwastesystems@gmail.com</u>
- Several homeowners have requested information from United Waste on how best to dispose
 of their grass clippings, since United Waste does not offer composting. They were directed
 to place the clippings in a separate bag, and place the bag on top of their trash can.
 - For PrairieStar residents there will be no charge for the first two bags (this is a special accommodation for PrairieStar only)—after the first 2 bags there will be an added \$10 fee
 - United Waste uses man-power only when picking-up trash/recycling, and therefore the reason for the separation of grass clippings is due to the fact that having them in the can will cause a weight problem for the workers—they still go in with the trash, but must be handled separately initially.
- If you have additional trash items (not grass clippings) please do not place the extra bags ontop of or near your receptacle. You can obtain an additional trash can from United Waste upon request for an added \$10 fee per month.

If you have any other questions regarding United Waste systems please let me know, or reachout to them directly. Rose and Sarah of United Waste are very familiar with our account—again, remember to let them know you are a PrairieStar resident when calling or emailing.
