HYDRANT or HOSE BIB CONNECTIONS TO YOUR SYSTEM

Box Elder Creek Ranch Water Company (the Water Company) allows the installation of a hydrant at the Property Owner's expense for hand watering trees and plants if the conditions below are met.

The Water Company requires that all Property Owners perform the following for hydrant installations:

- 1. Submit a completed Hydrant Application with the required \$10 fee to the Water Company. Owner will then receive a "Non-potable" water tag.
- 2. Owner can provide for a contractor to install hydrant plumbing only on the Owner's irrigation system beyond the Water Company's meter pit.
- 3. Above ground hydrant plumbing must be painted "purple" designating non-potable water.
- 4. The hydrant or valve must have a "non-potable water" tag attached at all times.
- 5. Note: Colorado law requires Owner's to call for utility locates prior to digging.

The irrigation water is <u>not treated to potable drinking water standards</u> and is not approved for human consumption. The Water Company's Rules and Regulations provide for the conditions to enforce the rules, regulations and requirements of the Water Company. The installation and cost of a hydrant is the Owner's responsibility.
