Invested in Recycling

- Waste Management was the first in Colorado to install a single stream processing system. In 2017, we invested \$5 million in new equipment in our Denver-area Material Recovery Facilities (MRF) bringing our 11 year total investment to \$16.5 million!
- Our Franklin Street MRF in Denver can now process up to 40 tons per hour, a 60% increase in capacity! With our new equipment and local partners, all the glass we collect in Colorado is recycled locally into new consumer products.
