I. - B. As Tree Treatment- The Board reviewed bids to get the ash trees either treated or removed. The Board agreed removing them is the best option, and the Landscape Committee will be doing that over the summer.
- C. Garage Door Violation- The Board instructed the Community Manager to send a violation for a damaged garage door.
- D. Landscape Committee Processes-
  - The Board asked the Community manager to send out an e-blast regarding water use rules per the City of Lafayette, as well as a general one about landscape maintenance in the community.
  - The Board discussed a rabbit repellant the Landscape Committee had tested. It is an organic compound and is working to protect the plants. The Board authorized the Committee to move forward using it in the community.
